1. Answer the following question in about 600 words.

What are the features of Indian English ? Is there a need for standard Indian English ? Why ?

Why is a daily lesson plan required ? Discuss the three important components of a lesson plan in terms of their relevance and significance.

2. Answer the following question in about 600 words.

What is the difference between listening for perception and listening for comprehension ? Exemplify, giving *two* activities of each type. Organize these activities in terms of the three stages of a listening class.

OR

What are the factors that a teacher needs to be aware of in order to develop writing skills in students ? Exemplify by suggesting two activities at the sentence - level.

3. Answer *any four* of the following questions in about **150** words each.
- (a) Discuss problems of teaching English in India with special reference to the post-independence phase.
 - (b) What is cognitive style ? Discuss the different types of cognitive style.
 - (c) Discuss the role of motivation in second language learning.
 - (d) Why do you think pair work and group work is better than a 'teacher - front' classroom ?
 - (e) How is speaking different from writing ? What implications does this have for a teacher ?
 - (f) What factors should you take into account when you are teaching the speaking skill in the classroom ?
 - (g) What is the criterion that should be adopted when selecting texts for intensive reading ?
