About NIMS

For creating a country imbued with scientific culture, immediately after independence, the Government of India planned to establish a centre of excellence in medical sciences for medical education and research in the country. With the generous grant from New Zealand under Colombo Plan, the foundation stone was laid in 1952 and the institute was finally created in 1956 as an autonomous institution through Parliament. Act of The institute comprehensive facilities for teaching, research and patient care. Teaching and research are conducted in 42 disciplines. At present, NIMS is not a single hospital but a conglomerate of hospitals like Centre Ophthalmology, for Cardiothoracic Surgery Centre, Neurosciences Centre and Medical Oncology Centre. NIMS cases to 1.5 million outpatients, 80.000 inpatients, 1,00,000 surgical operations every year.
