 - (a) What are the attributes and skills you expect from a trained distance education? Why are these attributes and skills important? Discuss with examples.

- (b) Mention at least three strategies you like to suggest for training of personnel involved in distance education system. Discuss the advantages and disadvantages of each strategy.
- 2. Answer any four of the following questions in about 300 words each:
 - (a) Why 'brainstorming' can be a suitable method of training? Discuss with examples.

- (b) Who are called 'proactive' trainers? How do they differ from the 'reactive' trainers?
- (c) Why is setting objectives for a training programme important?
- (d) Discuss the difference between "efficient" training and "effective" training. Give examples.
- (e) What are the criteria one should follow for selecting appropriate methods of training?
- (f) What are the pedagogical implications of 'Language Across Curriculum' (LAC) for staff development in distance education?
- **3.** Answer **any one** of the following questions in about **1200** words:
 - (a) Critically discuss the methods that are being used to identify training needs at the (i) institutional, (ii) job and (iii) person levels.
 - (b) Who are part time faculty in an Open University? Select any one category and prepare a 3-day training schedule for them. There must be 4 sessions per day (each session one and half hour duration). Mention the contents and strategies you like to include in each session. Justify your answer.
