- (v) What is urban planning ? Write a short note on the ancient urban planning and urban planning during the industrial revolution era.
- (vi) What is functional morphology of cities ? Describe any *four* salient features of morphology of Indian cities.
- (vii) What is master plan of a city ? Why is it necessary ? Discuss briefly its advantages.

- 8. Discuss the emergence of 'Inclusionist School' regarding urban informal economy. Analyse the case of home-based workers and street vendors in the informal sector of urban economy.
