Explain the importance of play in early childhood. What kind of play based activities would be appropriate for a five - year old child ?

3. Write short notes on **any four** of the following in about **150** words each.

- (c) Teaching health and safety measures.
- (d) Ways of encouraging creative thinking in pre-school children.
- (e) Essential elements for good child rearing.
- (f) Practices for developing mental hygiene during early childhood.
