- What are the rights of the trafficked person that 3. are violated during the process of trafficking?
- Discuss technology as a facilitator and a solution 4. to human trafficking.
- What steps can be taken to empower the 5. vulnerable persons so that they do not fall in the trap of trafficking?
- What are the elements that constitute trafficking 6. according to United Nations Protocol, 2000?
