About the University

The University of Delhi was established in 1922 as unitary, teaching and residential university and started with 3 colleges - St. Stephen college, Hindu college and Ramjas college with 2 faculties (Arts and science) and about 750 students. At present, there are 14 faculties, 86 academic departments, 79 colleges with about 2,20,000 students.

Faculties

The 14 faculties include Arts, Science, Applied Social Sciences and Humanities, Mathematical Sciences, Medical Sciences, etc. The Department of Library and Information Science courses under the faculty of Arts.

The Dept. Officers Bachelors, Masters, M.Phil and PhD degrees. The departmental library is fully automated having a collection of 18,000 documents

The Department awards JLIS scholarship and S.S. Saith Memorial scholarship.

Libraries

The university libraries consist of seven libraries which include university library system, Central science library, Ratan Tata library, South campus library, Arts library etc.

Du library system

More than 34 libraries constitute Du library system. It provides services through 29 electronic databases and 20 more databases available through UGC-INFONET. It provides on line services through OPAC, digital collections, UGC-INFONET e-resources, DELNET and public domain e-resources and bibliography of doctoral dissertations of the DU. The bibliography provides abstracts arranged year-wise by subjects.
