 - (c) Side view

- (b) Use A3 size ivory or cartridge sheet and B or 2B pencils for drawing.
- (c) Don't spend more than half an hour to complete the figure.

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3. Draw a fashion face in front view or side view and render it using pencil colours.

Guidelines:

- (a) Detailing of facial features, hairstyle and pencil rendering technique should be the main focus in your drawing.
- (b) Use A3 size ivory or cartridge sheet for drawing and pencil colours for rendering.
- (c) Don't spend more than one hour to complete your drawing and rendering.

4. Draw the flat sketch of **any one** of the following garments:

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- (a) One ladies Jacket with suitable collar and sleeves.
- (b) One ladies skirt with knife pleats.
- (c) A jamaica shorts.

- (a) Stitch mark, garment detailing, understanding of proportion and neatness should be the main focus in your drawing.
- (b) Use A3 size ivory or cartridge sheet and B or 2B pencils for drawing.
- (c) Don't spend more than half an hour to complete the drawing.
