 - (d) Explain the fence post approach.
 - (e) Explain the term 'Geographical Indications'.
 - (f) What do you understand by term injunction ?
 - (g) What is the role of Interpol for the prevention of IP crimes ?

- (a) Write a note on Pitu and Marrow Doctrine.
- (b) Discuss remedies for infringement of Trademarks and industrial design.
- (c) Explain the terms counterfeit trademark goods and pirated goods in the light of TRIPS Agreement.
- (d) Describe the role of Indian Customs Department in combating Intellectual Property Crimes.
- (e) Explain the role of WIPO in domain name dispute resolution.
- (f) State the grounds/basis on which court can set aside an arbitral award.
- (g) What reforms should be made in India to reduce piracy and to make the enforcement system in parity with TRIPS obligations ?
