4. Discuss the pre-requisites of Participatory Negotiation in the process of resettlement and rehabilitation.

5. Describe the different 'coping mechanisms' used for resolving conflicts arising in the situation of development induced displacement.
 6. Discuss the three methodological approaches in applied ethics to study the various dimensions of displacement caused by development projects.
 7. Discuss the significance of gender-sensitivity in designing and implementing the resettlement and rehabilitation plans for projects affected families (PAFs).
 8. In the light of the problems that squatters and encroachers face in claiming compensation, discuss the various ways of eliciting their participation in making resettlement and rehabilitation plans.
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
