2. Answer the following question in about 600 words :

Describe the role played by University Grants Commission in promoting Adult, continuing Education and Extention through Universities.

OR

Write a critique of conventional research. What are the advantages of participatory research over conventional research ?

3. Answer *any four* of the following questions in about **150** words each :

- (a) Reasons for non-utilisation of funds in implementing adult education programmes.
- (b) Need and significance of resource support structures in adult education.
- (c) Steps involved in pre - training phase of participatory training.
- (d) Different approaches to post - literacy and continuing education.
- (e) Inter-relationship between libraries and adult and continuing education.
- (f) Management structure of National Literacy Mission.

4. Answer the following question in about **600** words :

Suppose you are in - charge of implementation of adult education programmes at the grassroots level. Explain the roles you would play as an adult educator in enlisting the support and participation of local bodies, community and the individuals in implementation of any adult or continuing education programme of your choice.
